

Elders’ Quarterly Update

The Elders have been in discernment on the continuing need to have a positive, predictable & Scriptural sermon every Sunday. This has worked well for three years as part-time Pastor Paul had the support of Pastor Karen Lichlyter-Klein monthly on his “off” Sundays. Karen has resigned, and the need for a new pastoral team has emerged. The congregation needs to know the Elders have entered into a process to find a good fit to complete the Pastoral Team. The challenge is to find a gifted candidate to fill this role, even as giving is currently just meeting annual budget.

Elders believe that the congregation deserves continuity and predictability in pastoral services. We will give you periodic updates on our progress. We are open to any suggestions you may have during this season of discernment. Clusters or individuals may contact Rae, Jake
